- 4.I WOULD SET THE APERTURE TO F 18 OR F 16
- 5.I WOULD SET THE APERTURE TO F 1.4 TO LET IN THE MOST LIGHT
- 6.IF YOU USED AN APERTURE OF F 32 YOU WOULD BE ABLE TO FOCUS EVERYTHING IN YOUR PICTURE
- 7.ONLY THE SUBJECT WOULD BE IN FOCUS AT A CLOSE RANGE AND EVERYTHING ELSE WOULD HAVE A SHALLOW DEPTH OF FEEL
- 8.IF I WERE TO CAPTURE SOMETHING IN MOTION I WOULD SET THE SHUTTER SPEED TO 1/4000 S
